STEPS

DEPARTURE (if applicable)

Avoid leaving your luggage in public transportation (train or subway) in contact with other passengers' luggage.

MOVEMENTS (if applicable)

Take a seat, in your travels on public transportation, away from bags and luggage that do not belong to you.

INSPECTION (room)

Conduct an inspection (observation) of your rental spaces upon arrival. Pay particular attention (black spots) to your bed base, box spring, mattress, and bedding. See video clip.

INSPECTION (other rooms)


Give the same second look to chairs and sofas.

LUGGAGE (storage)

Keep your luggage away from the bedroom. Avoid placing it under your bed, especially. If possible, place them on the luggage rack (or in the bath).

RETURN

Wash your clothes as soon as you return. Then, put all your clothes in the dryer. Leave your suitcases outside, if possible, for a few days. Contact us if needed.

ROOM INSPECTION



1

DESCRIPTION (bed bug)

Bed bugs are wingless, blood-sucking insects measuring between 5 and 10 mm. They are brown-red in color. Their oval and flat bodies are visible to the naked eye (bed bugs resemble apple seeds).





2

DISTINCTION (signs)

A bed bug leaves evidence of its presence, such as small dark red stains. These are traces of blood. Bed bugs are most active at night and primarily live in the bedroom.

LIFE CYCLE (duration, hatching)

Bed bugs have an average lifespan of 5 to 6 months. They can live for over a year without feeding. Bed bug eggs are whitish, about the size of a pinhead, arranged in clusters (tight spaces). Hatching occurs approximately 10 to 14 days after being laid.

INSPECTION (hiding areas)

Pay particular attention to your bed base, box spring, mattress, openings, seams, and other junctions (headboard, legs, wooden slats). Refer to the video clip if needed.

INJURIES (bites)

They leave bites on exposed parts of the body during sleeping hours. The first bites may be grouped or aligned on the skin.
